What exactly is included?

It automatically updates in real time and as such is always changing. We revised our survey in 2018, therefore the audience size and makeup you are benchmarked against in this report may vary question by question. We match the benchmarking data to your own based on any demographic information such as, mission, size, or budget. The averages shown are drawn from around 47,000+ individuals and include a wide range of nonprofits.
